



Campsite Rules

The following recommendations are intended to ensure a pleasant stay for all campers.

Tents

- Tents may only be pitched at designated campsites.
- No holes may be dug for poles or pitchforks. Tents must have their own structure and stakes (no cutting branches or logs from the surrounding area).

Campfires

- Campfires allowed in designated campfire sites, must be supervised at all times and the fire must be extinguished when leaving.

The hour of silence

Silence must be observed from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 am.

Restrooms

- There are toilets in the auditorium and in the Visitor Centre.
- Tap water is NOT drinkable.
- No pots or pans can be washed in the sinks.
- Leave the toilet in the condition in which you would like to find it.

Security measures

- The Reserve has night watchmen.
- The Reserve is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- Do not swing or jump over the suspension bridges, it puts your safety and that of others at risk.

Wildlife

- Do not feed the animals, you may harm them and put your safety at risk.
- Wild animals are unpredictable, stay away and do not touch them.
- To see wildlife, keep quiet on trails.
- Stay on the trails, don't cut corners or take shortcuts.

General comments

- Persons causing disorder or not observing these rules will be expelled from camp without refund.
- Pets are not allowed.

- Place rubbish in receptacles.
- Please do not cut or pluck flowers and plants.
- Smoking is prohibited.

Lakeshore:

- If you want to swim remember that the water may be contaminated, avoid drinking water.
- There are no lifeguards, swim at your own risk.
- The beach has a rocky bed, be careful when entering the water, you may slip.
- Reeds (tulle) have been planted near the shore as a habitat for fish, crustaceans and birds, please do not pull them up.
